- 4. Technology and Digital Interventions: Examine the role of technology, apps, virtual platforms, or teletherapy in delivering effective sex therapy interventions and enhancing accessibility.
- 5. Ethical Considerations in Sex Therapy: Investigate ethical dilemmas, professional boundaries, and best practices in providing sex therapy services.
- 6. Sexuality and Relationships: Explore the interplay between sexuality and relationships, including couples therapy, intimacy, communication, and sexual satisfaction.
- 7. Cultural Perspectives on Sexual Health: Present research that sheds light on cultural variations, beliefs, and practices related to sexual health and therapy.

#### **Publication:**

Some papers will be chosen for publication in a yearly volume of the ISST Series. While participants are encouraged to submit proposals to any of the areas listed above, this year's focus will explore the Biopsychosocial understanding of sexuality and related treatment modalities.

- Abstracts should be 300 words or less.
- Submissions should be written in English.
- All papers should include your name, institutional affiliation, and email address.
- Please include a brief biography.

- Presentations should be 20 minutes in length.
- Presenters must be present at the symposium.
- Presenters must register for the symposium by the deadline, or their paper will not be listed on the schedule.
